Frida Kahlo's Museum

Frida and Diego envisioned her home as a museum for all Mexicans to cherish. Following her passing, their friend Carlos Pellicer, a museographer and poet, curated the exhibition. Its management was entrusted to the Fideicomiso de los Museos Diego Rivera y Frida Kahlo, established by Rivera himself in 1957 and overseen by the central bank, Banco de México.

Since its opening in July 1958, the Casa Azul and its gardens have showcased personal belongings, artworks, folk art, Pre-Columbian artifacts, photographs, documents, books, and furniture belonging to Frida and Diego. These items offer a glimpse into the environment that inspired Frida's creative spirit.
